Rules for Showing

NO ENTRIES WILL BE PLACED AFTER 5:30 P.M.

Exhibitor must be a resident of the Niagara area. Each exhibitor must fill out a REGISTRATION FORM and each exhibit must have a COMPLETED ENTRY CARD placed with the entry on the table.

Limited to ONE ENTRY IN ANY ONE CATEGORY PER EXHIBITOR. Exhibits MUST REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL 8:30 P.M. when awards will be presented, and photos taken, after which the exhibits may be removed. Exhibits must be picked up and removed by the exhibitor. For horticultural class entries, society vases must be used unless otherwise stated. Prize money will be mailed out within 2 weeks after the Show if not given out at the show.

The Welland Horticultural Society will not be responsible for loss or damage to containers, plants or personal property. N.B. Entries may be moved to a different horticultural class for the benefit of the entrant.

Entries in the Horticultural Division must have been grown by the exhibitor and in their possession for minimum of 3 months. More rules and definitions on in the insert.

Judging standards are in accordance with Publication #34 (2003) Ontario Judging & Exhibiting Standards. Judge's decision is final.

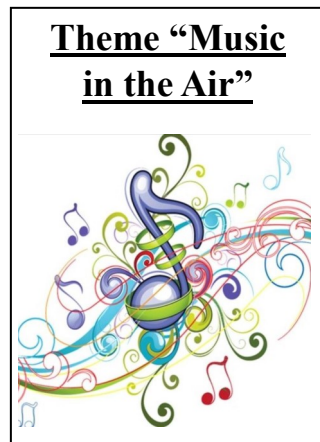

Class "A" Arrangements

- ◆ Using roses and other flowers (at least one rose must be included in each arrangement).
- ◆ Materials from any source. Accessories permitted.

1. **Small World** – A Small Design 5 ½" – 10" (14 cm – 25 cm) in any direction (height, width, depth, diagonal)
2. **You Don't Bring me Flowers** - A Foliage Design
3. **Twist and Shout** - A Design
4. **Under the Sea** - An Underwater Design
5. **Stand by Me** - A Parallel Design

CLASS "B" HYBRID TEA ROSES - SINGLE ROSE

6. PEACE
7. CITY OF WELLAND
8. WHITE
9. PINK (LIGHT)
10. PINK (MEDIUM)

23. 1 BLOOM - any colour - UNDER ¾" (2 cm)
24. 1 BLOOM - any colour – ¾" - 1½" (2 cm – 4 cm)
25. 1 BLOOM - any colour - OVER 1½" (4 cm)
26. 1 SPRAY - any colour - ANY SIZE

CLASS "D" CLIMBING ROSES

27. 1 SPRAY OF RED
28. 1 SPRAY - any OTHER colour (Not Hybrid Tea)
29. 1 SPRAY - HYBRID TEA - any colour
30. 1 BLOOM - HYBRID TEA - any colour

CLASS "E" FLORIBUNDA

31. 1 BLOOM - any colour
32. 1 SPRAY - any colour

CLASS "F" OTHER VARIETIES

33. 1 STEM or SPRAY - OLD GARDEN ROSE
34. 1 STEM or SPRAY - POLYANTHUS ROSE
35. 1 STEM or SPRAY – ANY SHRUB ROSE

CLASS "G" DAVID AUSTIN ROSE

36. 1 BLOOM - any colour
37. 1 SPRAY - any colour

CLASS "H" OPEN CLASS - ROSES

38. 1 BLOOM
39. 1 SPRAY
40. BLOOM with a Bud

CLASS "I" PEONIES

(in your own suitable container)

41. 1 STEM

CLASS "J" SMALL HOSTAS

LEAF LENGTH up to 6" (15 cm)

(in your own suitable container)

42. ANY SMALL HOSTA – one leaf
43. SMALL HOSTA – 3 leaves of different varieties

CLASS "K" MEDIUM HOSTAS

LEAF LENGTH 6" - 11" (15cm – 28 cm)

(in your own suitable container)

44. ANY MEDIUM HOSTA – one leaf
45. MEDIUM HOSTA – 3 leaves of different varieties

CLASS "L" LARGE HOSTAS

LEAF LENGTH 11" (28 cm) and over

(in your own suitable container)

46. ANY LARGE HOSTA – one leaf
47. LARGE HOSTA – 3 leaves of different varieties

CLASS "M" Display

(in your own suitable vase)

48. Perennials – min. of 3 to 5 varieties
49. Annuals – min. of 3 to 5 varieties
50. Roses – 5 stems or more
51. Peonies – 5 stems or more
